

VMMC holds the Ground Breaking Ceremony for the DPWH Evacuation Center

VMMC Director Dominador M. Chiong Jr. together with Quezon City First District Representative Anthony Peter “Onyx” Crisologo led the ceremonial ground breaking of the Department of Public Works and Highways’(DPWH) Evacuation Center on September 11, 2020 at the Veterans Memorial Medical Center.

The 48 Million evacuation facility will be constructed at the back of the Laundry Section beside the tennis court which will serve as temporary shelter of residents of nearby barangays in times of calamity and disaster.

The construction of the evacuation center has already commenced and is expected to be completed by June 2021. Likewise, the DPWH First District Engineering Office in coordination with the Engineering and Building Management Section will supervise the construction of the facility.

The VMMC officials and representatives from concluded the ceremony by burying a time capsule along with the ceremonial shovelling of the grounds where the center will be established.
